Qualifications for A Director of Kuukpik Corporation

- 18 years or older
- No felony convictions
- Must be an original shareholder of Kuukpik Corporation OR be the holder of 100 shares of Class A shares
- Must not be the original issue of stock from another village, urban or group corporation, except for shares received as a result of gift, inheritance or other transfer permitted by ANCSA
- Must be Alaska Native or descendant of an Alaska Native, as those terms are used in ANCSA

The information requested in this questionnaire is intended to ensure compliance with state proxy regulations. Kuukpik reserves the right, in its discretion, to request additional information it deems necessary to comply with the regulations.

INSTRUCTIONS

<u>Answer Every Question</u>. You must answer every question in this questionnaire, even if the answer is "None" or "Not Applicable.". If you determine that a question does not apply to you, write "Not Applicable" or "N/A."

<u>Current Directors and Officers</u>. Every current officer and director of a Kuukpik Company must annually file a completed, signed questionnaire which is received by Kuukpik not later than the Filing Deadline stated below.

<u>Nominees for the Kuukpik Board</u>. Any person running for a seat on the Kuukpik Board who wants to be included in the proxy solicitation material by Kuukpik must file a completed, signed questionnaire. All documents must be received by Kuukpik not later than the Filing Deadline stated below. The Nominations Committee may reject the application of any nominee who has not submitted a completed, signed questionnaire. Minor defects in the questionnaire may be waived by vote of the Nominations Committee.



<u>Filing Deadline</u>. All questionnaires and must be received by Kuukpik no later than **5:00 p.m. on March 31, 2023**.

<u>Applicants</u>. Any person seeking or being considered for appointment or hiring to a position as an officer or director of any Kuukpik Company must file a completed questionnaire no later than the date established by management.

<u>New Directors and Officers</u>. Unless a person filed a questionnaire prior to taking a position as an officer or director, a person taking a position as an officer or director of any Kuukpik Company must file a completed questionnaire no later than the 30th day after taking the position.

KUUKPIK CORPORATION CODE OF CONDUCT

Scope

This policy applies to all Kuukpik board members, employees, and shareholders in their interactions with each other and the public regarding Kuukpik corporate affairs or when representing Kuukpik in any other capacity.

Intent and Underlying Values

Kuukpik Corporation and the people who represent it in any capacity are responsible to each other for the survival of Inupiat values and traditions. As such, all board members, employees, and shareholders are expected to conduct the corporation's business in a way that is consistent with those values, including:

- Compassion
- Cooperation
- Humility
- Humor
- Hunting Traditions
- Spirituality and Religion
- Family and Kinship
- Love and Respect of Elders
- Avoidance of Conflict
- Knowledge of Language
- Sharing
- Respect for Nature

Respect for these values can form a foundation for all those who represent Kuukpik to work together to promote mutual respect and cooperation, to achieve our common goal of building and developing innovative opportunities, partnerships and leadership, and to ensure and perpetuate the Kuukpikmiut's self-sufficiency, economic growth, and cultural heritage.

Interactions with the Public and Each Other

- Kuukpik board members, employees, and shareholders must be aware that when they discuss matters of corporate concern, publicly or privately, they may be seen as Kuukpik Representatives.
- Anyone acting on Kuukpik business or as a Kuukpik Representative should conduct themselves in a way that reflects well on the corporation.
- When speaking on behalf of the corporation, or in other public statements or actions or when speaking as an individual member, Kuukpik Representatives shall at all times be accurate, exercise appropriate restraint, and show respect for other shareholders, board members, employees, the public, and the opinions of others.



- Personal attacks have no place in the corporation.
- Kuukpik Representatives should be open to new ideas and respectful of opposing views from anyone they deal with while on corporation business, including shareholders, board members, or members of the public.

Fulfillment of Corporate Responsibilities

- Board members and employees should fulfill their corporate duties with integrity and respect toward each other, shareholders, and the community. Supervisors should not abuse their authority.
- Shareholders, board members, and employees should be friendly and collaborative. They should not disrupt the workplace or present obstacles to the work of others.
- All Kuukpik Representatives should treat the company's property with respect and care.
- Kuukpik Representatives should behave lawfully. They should comply with all safety, environmental, and fair dealing laws, and be ethical and responsible when dealing with Kuukpik's finances, partners, and the public.
- All employees should read and follow the Employment Handbook. Board members are expected to be familiar with and follow the Articles of Incorporation, Corporate Bylaws, and Policies of the Board of Directors. This Code of Conduct is not intended to change or overrule any policies in the Handbook or of the Board.
- Board members and employees should avoid any personal, financial, or other interests that might hinder their capability or willingness to perform their duties on behalf of Kuukpik.
- Kuukpik Representatives should be fair and impartial in their dealings with one another and avoid actions which adversely affect, or appear to adversely affect, their duties to the corporation.
- Employees and board members have a duty to safeguard all confidential information of the Corporation, its shareholders, or third parties with which the Corporation conducts business, except when disclosure is authorized or legally mandated.

Non-Discrimination

• No one affiliated with Kuukpik shall engage in any discrimination, harassment, or use of any verbally derogatory statement based on race, religious creed, color, age, sex, physical or mental disability, national origin, ancestry, marital status, or other personal trait.
